The home of **ABT Sportsline** is Bavaria, which, for good reasons, is deemed a real snowboarding and skiing paradise. Anyway, you should have good winter tires when you want to go to a skiing resort by car. And to leave a good impression in visual terms as well, we recommend the attractive complete winter wheels by **ABT**: You can now get them at a bargain price in combination with seven different alloy wheels – **Z6** silver, **CR19** charcoal-coloured or **CR19** silverlight, **CR 20** “diamantbedreht”/charcoal-coloured or **CR20** silver-light, **DR20** or **CR22** silverlight.

Basically, for **ABT Sportsline** it's also always about performance. “That is why we use high-quality winter tires by Dunlop, Michelin, Pirelli and Vredestein for our complete wheels”, says **Hans-Jürgen Abt**, general manager of the globally largest tuner of cars produced by the Volkswagen Group. The dimensional range of the **ABT** complete wheels covers almost all models by Audi, SEAT, Škoda and VW, from compact cars up. The current promotion features a total of eleven different tire-wheel combinations.

The 18-inch wheel **ABT Z6** in silver with the Vredestein Wintrac Xtreme (225/40R18), for example, is very suitable for the VW Golf and the SEAT Leon or also the Audi TT or Škoda Superb. At 1,590 Euros, this is the **ABT** winter world entry level.

For the full-size SUVs like Audi Q7 and VW Touareg it should rather be the 20-inch **CR20 silver-light** with the Michelin Latitude in 275/40R20 at 2,990 Euros.

Large limos and estate cars – Audi A6, A7 and A8 – can be adorned with a real 20-inch highlight: the dark **ABT DR20** is exclusively hooped with the Dunlop SP Winter Sport (4,990 Euros) and as a mark of ultimate performance bears the **ABT Motorsport** logo.

The **ABT** engineers have always seen to high performance when selecting tires, by the way. Thus they chose combinations that are not only utterly winter-worthy but also help drivers to let their cars perform with their usual “aplomb”.
