

ABT Sportsline 2019 – Press Release CW21 ABT Golf R and "DA Team bus" at Wörthersee

At the first GTI meeting 37 years ago, a VW bus would have been used as mobile accommodation at best. The VW T2 and T3 at the time were just too practical to be of interest to fans of sporty, individual vehicles. But in 1983, the US TV series "The A-Team" soon proved how cool a minivan can be. The leading role in the series, however, was "played" by a GMC Vandura, which appeared much more powerful and martial than the VW bus models at the time. The current VW T6, that Youtuber and race driver Daniel Abt turned into his brand new **DA-Team bus** with plenty of extras, is a different story. He will be using it to cruise to his social media appointments with his crew. Together with an **ABT Golf R**, the cool bus will now be presented for the first time in Reifnitz at Wörthersee from May 29 until June 1, 2019. The world's largest tuner for vehicles from Audi and Volkswagen will be based in exhibition area 2 together with its partner H&R.

The **T6 DA-Team bus** is equipped with a complete **ABT aero package**. This includes an **ABT front skirt add-on, front grille add-on, side strips, rear wing** and a **rear skirt set** from which an **ABT rear muffler** with black pipes protrudes. The 20-inch alloy wheels type **ABT Sport GR**, painted in a custom red color, provide an exciting counterpoint. The already strong 2.0 liter production diesel engine with 204 HP (150 kW) received a significant boost from **ABT Sportsline**. With the auxiliary **ABT Engine Control** unit, the T6 now offers an impressive 235 HP (173 kW). The maximum torque increased from 450 to 490 Nm.

While the GTI still ruled the "Golf pack" in 1982, this position has been taken over by the Golf R in the past ten years. In the production version, the 2019 model of this compact rocket already provides 300 HP (221 kW) and a torque of 400 Nm. In the early 1980s, figures like these could barely be reached by a Porsche 911 Turbo. The world's largest automotive aftermarket and performance parts specialist for Audi and VW went a step further, though, and installed its **ABT Power** boost in the Golf R for the GTI meeting at Wörthersee. The auxiliary **ABT Engine Control** (AEC) unit provides an impressive increase to 350 HP (257 kW), with the maximum torque growing from 400 to 440 Nm. Suspension springs from H&R ensure that not only the longitudinal dynamics are right. As in the **DA T6**, the Golf R engine also exhales through an **ABT muffler system** with black tailpipes. For the perfect look the car is equipped with 20-inch alloy wheels type **ABT Sport GR** in glossy black.

Overall, **ABT Sportsline** will be presenting two exhibits which are absolute must-sees.
